PONYCORN

WHAT YOU Need:

- 1 cup butter
- 2 cups brown sugar
- ½ cup corn syrup
- 1 tsp salt
- ½ tsp baking sofa
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 5 quarts popped popcorn

MeTHOD:

- 1. Preheat oven to 250 degrees F (95 degrees C). Place popcorn in a very large bowl.
- 2. In a medium saucepan over medium heat, melt butter. Stir in brown sugar, corn syrup and salt.
- 3. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly. Boil without stirring 4 minutes. Remove from heat and stir in soda and vanilla. Pour in a thin stream over popcorn, stirring to coat.
- 4. Place in two large shallow baking dishes and bake in preheated oven, stirring every 15 minutes, for 1 hour. Remove from oven and let cool completely before breaking into pieces.
- 5. **eNJOY!**

WHAT YOU Need:


- 17 fl oz unsweetened almond milk
- 2 tbsp almond butter
- 6 prunes
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 small ripe banana

MeTHOD:



- In a blender, whizz the almond milk with the almond butter, prunes, cinnamon and banana.
- 2. Transfer to 2 bottles and chill until ready to drink, or pack for on the go!






- 4 tbsp coconut milk yogurt
- 1 banana
- 1 tbsp ground flaxseed, sunflower and pumpkin seed
- 4.25 oz frozen mango chunks
- 1 passion fruit, to finish
- 1. Put them into a blender and blitz until smooth. Pour into 1 tall glass (you'll have enough for a top up) or two short tumblers.
- 2. Cut the passion fruit in half, if using, and scrape the seeds on top.

- 6 oz blueberries
- 1 small banana, sliced
- 1 tbsp natural or Greek yogurt
- 3.5 fl oz apple juice, chilled
- 3-4 mint leaves







2. Pour the smoothie into a tall glass with a glass straw to serve. Garnish with a sprig of mint, if you like.

WREATH

WHAT YOU Need:

- Craft paper 5-6 colors (one of which is green)
- Cardstock paper any color, for the wreath base
- Pencil or pen for tracing the template
- Scissors
- Craft glue or glue stick
- Your favourite arts and crafts: feathers, gems, glitter (Izzy's fave!)






















MeTHOD:

- 1. Select a colored craft paper for the flower and cut a 12 inches long strip (1 to 2 inches wide).
- 2. Create small and even accordion folds on the strip.
- 3. Create zigzag patterns along any one sides of the folded strip. Use the folds as guides for each zigzag.
- 4. Use craft glue to join both sides (width) of the accordion folded strip. Now we have an accordion folded roll.
- 5. Hold the plain side of the roll and press it towards the center. Flatten the roll by holding all the folds of the plain side and pressing them towards the center.
- 6. Cut out 2 round shapes from yellow colored papers and glue one of those on the center of the pressed paper. Similarly glue the other circle on the other side of the paper to secure the flattened piece (accordion folded).
- Create more flowers and patterns to make the wreath.
- 8. Determine the size of the wreath and cut out a round base of at least 2 inches width.
- 9. Start to glue the flowers on the base first.
- 10. Done adding all the flowers? Add gems, sparkles, glitter, feathers – or any of your favorite craft decorations.
- 11. Allow the glue to dry once you are happy.
- 12. Your wreath is ready.
